

## Cumulative Index for NDPLS Articles 1997-2022

This index of key words was compiled as an aid to our readers and authors. It provides a concise list of the topics that we have covered thus far. It is now current through the issue of October, 2022. New index terms have been added since the last installment of the index that was published in April, 2021.

The index was compiled from key words that were supplied by the authors. The lexicon was then condensed to ignore singular versus plural forms of the same word, combine synonyms, and cross-relate to similar concepts. Key words that appeared in titles are also included here. Entries for each key word are formatted as [journal volume]:[page range]. Multiple articles for a key word are separated by a comma and listed in chronological order of their publication. The book reviews have also been indexed using the key words already available. This index also appears on the journal's web site.
